You have the legal right to mail or deliver this application directly to the KERN COUNTY ELECTIONS OFFICE. Only the registered voter himself or herself may apply for a Vote by Mail Ballot. An application for a Vote by Mail Ballot made by a person other than the registered voter is a criminal offense. Anyone who receives completed application forms shall return the forms to the appropriate elections official within 72 hours of receiving the forms, or before the deadline for application, whichever is sooner. (Election Code Section 3008)
